The first weekend, November 12<sup>th</sup> and November 13<sup>th</sup> kicks off with the 1997 - 2005 at the San Diego Polo Fields. See specifics below:

## Nov 12th – Saturday Boys & Girls 2002 (Flight 2 Gold), and Boys & Girls 2003, 2004 and 2005 Flights 1 & 2 Gold.

- Olympic Development Program (ODP).
- There will be ODP Scouts in attendance.
- There will be a midday meet and greet with the ODP Staff for questions and information.

## Nov 13th – Sunday Boys and Girls 1997-2001 and 2002 Flight 1 (College Showcase) \*\*

- There will be College Coaches in attendance.
- There will be 2 College Coach Panels (10am and 2pm) for information and questions.

### \*\* NOTE - No Showcase for Boys 1997-1999 Flight 2

The second weekend, November 19<sup>th</sup> and November 20<sup>th</sup> uses multiple locations with kick offs at Coronado and Hickman.

## Nov 19th – Saturday Boys 2006 -2008 (Festival Showcase) - location is Coronado Cays.

## Nov 20th – Sunday Girls 2006-2008 (Festival Showcase) - location is Coronado Cays.

## Nov 19th – Saturday Boys 2004 Flight 2 Blue and Boys 2005 Flight 2 Blue - location is Hickman.

## Nov 19th – Saturday Boys 2001 Flight 2 Blue and Boys 2002 Flight 2 Blue - location is Hickman.

### What you need to know:

Game times: 1997 – 2001      30 minute halves, 60 minute game (running clock- no stoppage time)  
2002 Flight 1              30 minute halves, 60 minute game (running clock- no stoppage time)  
2002 FL2 - 2005        25 minute halves, 50 minute game (running clock - no stoppage time)  
2006 - 2008              20 minute halves, 40 minute game (running clock - no stoppage time)

- Teams **MUST** be in uniform and ready to play 5 minutes before scheduled start time. Field space is completely full and games **MUST** stay on-time.
- Each team is responsible for one-half the referee fees per game as shown below:

1997 - 2001	\$90 Total	Each team brings \$45 consisting of 1-\$20, 1- \$10, 2-\$5 & 5-\$1
2002 Flight 1	\$90 Total	Each team brings \$45 consisting of 1-\$20, 1- \$10, 2-\$5 & 5-\$1
2002 FL2 - 2005	\$76 Total	Each team brings \$38 consisting of 1-\$20, 1-\$10, 1-\$5 & 3-\$1
2006 - 2008	\$60 Total	Each team brings \$30 consisting of 1-\$20, 1-\$5, & 5-\$1

- Parents/spectators must sit on the opposite side of the field directly across from their team.
- **NO DOGS or SMOKING IS ALLOWED ON ANY VENUE OR FIELDS.**
- Team check-in will be done by the referees prior to the game.
- **Home team will input the game scores online with the mobile app – Digital Player Card after each game.**

Game can be easily scored from your cell phone. Here is the link to [Digital Player Card](#). Save this page as a shortcut icon on your phone. Login with your USERNAME and PASSWORD, input the game number and click on the search icon. Then to score the game click on the word "Scoring". Full instructions are listed in the Team Administrator Guide as Digital Player Card Exhibit L. OR

Once on your "My Account" page, under Tournament Application/Game Scoring, find the Tournament 2016 SDDA Showcase, then click link "Schedules/Game Scoring", then score game as you normally would.

## Polo Fields Information

- Freeway I-5 Exit at Via De La Valle. Go East past El Camino Real. Follow the signs to entrance on right on Via De La Valle.
- Parking at San Diego Polo Fields is \$10 per day, all other locations are free.
- Field Marshall locations at the San Diego Polo Fields will be available to help answer basic questions and provide field locations.
- Three professional trainers will be on site at the San Diego Polo Fields.
- ODP coaches will be at the San Diego Polo Fields on Saturday.
- College coaches will be at the San Diego Polo Fields on Sunday.
- A College Talk will be held in the big tent Sunday at 10am and 2pm.

Reminder – No Dogs or smoking is allowed on any venue or fields.
