1. Call to Order.

Meeting called to order by Bob Turner at 10:10 a.m.

2. Special Committee Report.

- a. Executive Board** – Gave an overview of the subcommittee meeting providing recommendations for Presidio/SDDA re USSF/Cal South Player Development Initiatives. The subcommittee also recommended tabling the build out line decisions for a couple months to see what Cal South will mandate for State Cup so we can be on the same page.

- a. Birth Season Matrix** – attached.
- b. US Soccer Player Development Initiative Small Sided Standards (2016-17)** – The member clubs present discussed that they would like clubs to have a 7v7 field and a 9v9 field as the fields should be different sizes. Clubs should only use 1 field size for both if they have no other option space-wise. Brian Quinn suggested that the 7v7 field be 70 x 50 and the 9v9 be 75 x 55. Roster sizes were also addressed that USSF allows too many players per team especially for the younger ages, however, at this point since teams have been formed, member clubs cannot go in now and make restrictions.
- c. 2009/U8s** -- The 2009 age group (U8s) will play 7v7 in Presidio/SDDA using the rules for 2008s. The bracket will be called U9B or 2008B. Members clubs

present preferred 7v7 over 4v4 for the age group. Coast Soccer League has stated that they will continue with their policy to not have a bracket for the U8s. Bob Turner stated that if the member clubs did want to play 4v4 then Presidio/SDDA would accommodate that – for example, two teams could each bring up to 14 players and then have those players break into two side-by-side games of 4v4. Again, the member clubs stated they preferred the 7v7 format.

- d. **Team Seeding** – This year’s team seeding will be more difficult and SDDA/Presidio will trust the DOCs to properly seed their teams. However, team rosters will be verified by the Board.
- e. **Tryouts --** The discussion from last month’s meeting was reiterated that all clubs need to move tryouts to later dates after State Cup instead of in January as is common across San Diego County.

**SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS RE
USSF/CAL SOUTH PLAYER DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES**

REVISED TO INCLUDE SDDA MTG DISCUSSION OF FEB. 8, 2016

1. Field Sizes.

7 v 7 and 9 v 9 Recommendation is to make two different sized fields –

7 v 7 = 60 x 45

9 v 9 = 75 x 55 (this field could be longer)

*this year only the U11 (2006) age group is playing 9 v 9

If can only provide one field for both 7 v 7 and 9 v 9 recommend the field be 70 x 50

11 v 11 = Range could be 100 x 60 to 120 x 80

U12 (this year) – U14 would be on smaller end of range

2. Ball Sizes.

No size 3.

Size 4 for U12 and younger

Size 5 for U13* and older

*Need to have U13 use what will be used in State/Nat'l Cup

3. Game Times.

U9 - U10 = 2 x 25

U11-U12 = 2 x 30

U13-U14 = 2 x 35

U15-U16 = 2 x 40

U17-U19 = 2 x 45

ALL AGES: 5 MINUTE HALFTIME

For Presidio/SDDA scheduling purposes allow 10 minutes between games

4. Goal Sizes.

7 v 7 and 9 v 9 = 7 x 21 preferred; 6.5 x 18 okay

11 v 11 = 8 x 24

5. Build Out Line.

Only used in 7 v 7 – line would run width of the field running across the top of the penalty arc. Could mark the line with flags on sidelines or paint across field with a different color than the other field lining. Would only be mandatory on goal kicks.

6. Offsides.

Used for all 7 v 7, 9 v 9 and 11 v 11.

The Cal South/Presidio roster sizes are as follows:

- U16 (2001) - U19/U20 (1998) = 22 players with 18 eligible and 11 aside
- U12 (2005) - U15 (2002) = 18 with 11 aside (U12/2005 will be 11 on the field for this year only next year U12 /2006 will be 9 aside)
- U11 (2006) = 18 players with 9 aside
- U9B (2009) - U10 (2007) = 14 with 7 aside

This chart is organized to demonstrate how players will progress when registering by birth year. It displays the exact same information as the "Birth Year and Season Matrix" found above. Again, please note that when determining the age group for a season, the year the competition ends should be used.
 • Ex: 2017-18 = 2018 - U7 = 2011

Statement from Youth Council Technical Working Group to U.S. Soccer

To: Leaders and members of U.S. Soccer
From: Youth Council technical leaders
Subject: Inclusion in policy discussions



CHARLESTON, S.C. (Feb. 5, 2016) - The Youth Council Technical Working Group unanimously agreed that there has been generally insufficient dialogue between the U.S. Soccer Federation technical staff and the technical leadership of the various youth membership organizations.

Substantial questions remain about the impact of the new calendar-year registration model, and the interpretation that a player's eligible competition year is determined by his/her age in the year in which the competition ends. This change results in every player moving up one age group and may not align appropriately with the mandated age appropriate play guidelines.

There are broad concerns about the efficacy of those new guidelines, which should have been addressed prior to broad dissemination of the materials.

Not only does the Federation have a responsibility to discuss such broad issues with its membership, but a transparent and inclusive process will produce better outcomes for everyone.

The Youth Council Technical Working Group would like the Federation to agree to a formal, institutionalized communications process to ensure that an ongoing dialogue is established with the youth members. Federation technical and administrative leadership should schedule approximately three meetings annually with the Youth Council Technical Working Group and other meetings as needed with ad-hoc sub-committees of the Group.

Specific issues, which should be discussed include:

- Calendar-year birth date and implications
- Age-appropriate play guidelines
 - Field sizes

- Goal sizes
- Team sizes
- Build-out lines
- Concussion protocols and practical implications
- Modifications to the Laws to accommodate the above
- Broad player development philosophy
- Coaching education policies
 - Licensing philosophy
 - Access
 - Communication
 - CEU's

It is the intention of the Youth Council Technical Working Group to cooperate closely with the Federation and support its efforts to raise the standard of development for all youth players. Through regular dialogue and a rigorous examination of these and other related issues, we believe that the best outcomes can be achieved for all interested parties.
